Page 18, line 34 [Schedule 1], leave out paragraph 5 and insert—

- ‘5 (1) The ISC may only publish or disclose information provided to it by an intelligence service or a department of Her Majesty’s Government—
- (a) by way of a report under section 3;
 - (b) if the ISC and the Prime Minister are satisfied that publication or disclosure would not be prejudicial to the continued discharge of the functions of an intelligence service or any person carrying out activities falling within section 2(2); or
 - (c) when such publication or disclosure is necessary for the ISC to comply with any enactment or rule of law.
- (2) In this paragraph “intelligence service” has the meaning given by section 15(6).’.
