**B**E IT ENACTED by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

**1 Fixed-term Parliaments Act (Repeal)**

The Fixed-term Parliaments Act 2011 is hereby repealed.

**2 Short title, commencement and extent**

- (1) This Act may be cited as the Fixed-term Parliaments (Repeal) Act 2015.
- (2) This Act comes into force on 8 May 2015.
