
MENTAL CAPACITY (AMENDMENT) BILL [LORDS]

Standing Order No. 830

For the purposes of Standing Order No. 830, and on the basis of material put before me, I certify that in my opinion that for the purposes of SO No. 830(2), the following motions relating to the Lords Message (27 February 2019) on the Mental Capacity (Amendment) Bill [Lords] relate exclusively to England and Wales and are within devolved legislative competence, as defined in Standing Order No. 83J:

That this House does not insist on Commons Amendment No. 1 to which the Lords have disagreed, disagrees to Lords Amendment No. 1B proposed instead of Commons Amendment No. 1 but proposes Amendment (a) to insert new Clause (*Deprivation of liberty: code of practice*) in lieu of the Lords Amendment; and

That this House disagrees to Lords Amendment No. 25A proposed to Commons Amendment No. 25 but proposes Amendments (a) and (b) to Commons Amendment No. 25 in lieu of the Lords Amendment.
