If the Bill is reported from the Committee of the whole House as amended, there could be a report (consideration) stage, but Mr Speaker is unlikely to select for report stage any New Clauses or Amendments which have been (or could have been) tabled for Committee of the whole House.

Proceedings on Third Reading may continue up to no later than 6 hours after the start of proceedings on the Business of the House Motion relating to the Bill (if that Business of the House Motion is agreed to): the same time limit as for Committee of the whole House and for any proceedings at report (consideration) stage.
