Amend the Scotland Act 1998 to grant legislative competence for employment matters to the Scottish Parliament.

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 Legislative competence for employment

In Part 2 of Schedule 5 to the Scotland Act 1998 (specific reservations), omit Head H and paragraphs H1 to H3 (employment).

2 Extent, commencement and short title

- (1) Any repeal made by this Act has the same extent as the provision repealed. 5
- (2) This Act comes into force on the day on which it is passed.
- (3) This Act may be cited as the Devolution (Employment) (Scotland) Act 2021.
