There will formally be a report stage, because the Bill is expected to be amended in Committee (see Gov19). Report stage and Third Reading must be completed no later than 5 hours from the start of proceedings in Committee of the whole House.

The Speaker is not likely to select amendments at report stage which could have been tabled for Committee.

If the 5-hour knife is reached before debate starts on third reading, the Question "That the Bill be now read the third time" will be decided without debate.
