BE IT ENACTED by the King's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 Amendment of Ministerial and other Pensions and Salaries Act 1991

- (1) Section 4 of the Ministerial and other Pensions and Salaries Act 1991 is amended as follows.
- (2) In subsection 6(a), at end insert “, provided that the person has held such an office continuously for two years or more”.

2 Extent, commencement and short title

- (1) This Act extends to England and Wales, Scotland and Northern Ireland.
- (2) This Act comes into force on the day on which it is passed.
- (3) This Act may be cited as the Ministerial and other Pensions and Salaries (Amendment) Act 2022.
