A Bill which has been committed to a Committee of the whole House would have a consideration (report) stage only if it had been amended in Committee.

Under the Programme Order of 12 December,

- any proceedings on consideration must be brought to a conclusion no later than one hour before the moment of interruption, and Third Reading must be brought to a

conclusion no later than the moment of interruption, on whichever day after CWH Day 2 the Bill is taken; or

- if the Bill is not amended in Committee, proceedings on Third Reading must be brought to a conclusion no later than one hour after the commencement on the day when the Bill is reported without amendment from Committee.
