Amend Schedule 9 to the Equality Act 2010 to prohibit age discrimination by employers in relation to the provision of insurance or a related financial service; and for connected purposes.

BE IT ENACTED by the King's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 Amendment of the Equality Act 2010

- (1) Schedule 9 to the Equality Act is amended as follows.
- (2) Omit paragraph 14.

2 Consequential provision

- (1) The Secretary of State may by regulations make consequential provision for the purposes of, or in connection with, giving full effect to a provision of this Act. 5
- (2) The regulations may (among other things) amend, repeal or revoke a provision contained in, or in an instrument made under, an Act of Parliament.
- (3) A statutory instrument containing regulations made under this section is subject to annulment in pursuance of a resolution of either House of Parliament. 10

3 Extent, commencement and short title

- (1) This Act extends to England and Wales and Scotland.
- (2) This Act comes into force at the end of the period of three months beginning with the day on which this Act is passed. 15
- (3) This Act may be cited as the Employment Equality (Insurance etc) Act 2024.
