BE IT ENACTED by the King’s most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 Exemption of motor homes from caravan site licensing requirements

- (1) The Caravan Sites and Control of Development Act 1960 is amended as follows.
- (2) In section 29(1), in the definition of “caravan”—
 - (a) after “trailer”, omit “and any motor vehicle so designed or adapted,”; 5
and
 - (b) after “include—”, insert—
 - “(za) any motor vehicle designed or adapted for human habitation.”

2 Extent, commencement and short title

- (1) This Act extends to England and Wales and Scotland.
- (2) This Act comes into force at the end of the period of two months beginning with the day on which it is passed.
- (3) This Act may be cited as the Caravan Site Licensing (Exemption of Motor Homes) Act 2024. 15
