BE IT ENACTED by the King's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 Amendments to the Caravan Sites and Control of Development Act 1960

- (1) Section 3 of Caravan Sites and Control of Development Act 1960 (issue of site licences by local authorities) is amended as follows.
- (2) Subsections (3) and (5) are repealed.
- (3) In subsection (4), omit from “he” to “aforesaid”.

2 Extent, commencement and short title

- (1) This Act comes into force on the day on which it is passed.
- (2) This Act applies to England and Wales only.
- (3) This Act may be cited as the Caravan Sites Act 2024.
