**Compliance with domestic and international law; safety of Rwanda conditional on implementation of the Treaty and reports from Monitoring Committee on implementation of the Treaty; ability of decision-makers to consider whether Rwanda is a safe country and jurisdiction of domestic courts to grant interim relief; court review of decisions based on assessment of claimant's age; removal of victims of modern slavery and human trafficking; exemption for agents, allies and employees of the UK overseas**
