*Resolved*, That the following Reason be assigned to the Lords for disagreeing to their 1B, 2B, 7B and 8B, and their Amendments 15B to 15E to the words restored to the Bill by the Lords non-insistence on their Amendment 15, to the Non-Domestic Rating (Multipliers and Private Schools) Bill:

Because the Lords Amendment interferes with the public revenue and affects the levy and application of local revenues, and the Commons do not offer any further Reason, trusting that this Reason may be deemed sufficient. — (*The Chair.*)
