84A★ Page 36, line 32, at end insert—

- “(4) As soon as possible following enactment, the Secretary of State shall arrange for a review of—
- (a) whether paragraph 18(1), (1A) and (1B) of Schedule 9 to the Equality Act 2010 should be repealed, and
 - (b) if so, what if any statutory provision should be made for civil partners and married couples of the same sex in relation to occupational pensions and survivor rights.
- (5) The Secretary of State must arrange for a report on the outcome of the review to be produced and published within six months following enactment.
- (6) The Secretary of State may by order make provision for and in connection with—
- (a) the repeal of paragraph 18(1), (1A) and (1B) of Schedule 9 to the Equality Act 2010,
 - (b) any other recommendations of the review.
- (7) An order under sub-paragraph (6) may amend any England and Wales legislation.”
