TO

Amend the Ministerial and Other Salaries Act 1975 in order to increase the maximum number of salaries payable to Secretaries of State; and to make provision about the Leader of the House of Lords.

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen’s most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 Amendments to the Ministerial and Other Salaries Act 1975

- (1) Part V of Schedule 1 to the Ministerial and Other Salaries Act 1975 (Ministerial salaries) is amended as follows.
- (2) In paragraph 2(a), for “21” substitute “22”.
- (3) After paragraph 2, insert—
“3 One of the Secretary of State offices under Part I to this Schedule must be held by the person appointed as Leader of the House of Lords.”

2 Extent, commencement and short title

- (1) This Act extends to England and Wales, Scotland and Northern Ireland.
- (2) This Act comes into force on the day on which it is passed.
- (3) This Act may be cited as the Leader of the House of Lords Act 2014.
