## AMENDMENTS TO BE MOVED ON REPORT

---

### Clause 1

LORD MCKENZIE OF LUTON

Page 1, line 6, leave out subsection (2) and insert –

- “(2) After subsection (2) (which imposes a general duty with respect to health and safety on self-employed persons) insert –
  - “(2A) Nothing in subsection (2) shall preclude the Secretary of State from making regulations exempting self-employed persons carrying out certain activities from the provisions of section 3(2) or from specified regulations thereunder where it can be shown that their work activities pose no potential risk of harm to others.””

### Clause 11

BARONESS THORNTON

Page 8, line 22, at end insert –

- “(e) the person who made the booking has consented to their booking being sub-contracted to a second operator.
- (1A) A licensing authority may exercise all its powers over a vehicle licensed as a private hire vehicle or taxi if it is operating in their area, even if the licence was issued by another licensing authority.”

Page 120, line 12, at end insert –

- “( ) The Secretary of State may by regulations make rules according to which the authority shall make decisions under this Schedule.”

Page 188, line 2, at end insert –

“(4A) The alcohol must be sold for no less than fifty pence per unit.”

Page 188, line 2, at end insert –

“(4B) The Secretary of State may, by regulations made by statutory instrument no less than 3 years after the passing of this Act, repeal or otherwise modify subsection (4A).”

Insert the following new Clause –

**“Referendums on changing local authority governance system**

In the Local Government Act 2000, omit section 9NA (effect of section 9N order).”

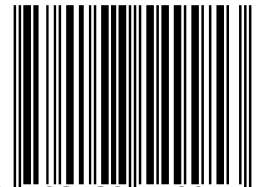
