LORD HUNT OF WIRRAL

196A★

Insert the following new Clause—

“Disclosure of information by HMRC for certain purposes related to insurance

- (1) The Revenue and Customs may disclose information held by them to a specified person for the purposes of a specified objective.
- (2) The information to which this section applies is limited to—
 - (a) the name and address of an employer;
 - (b) the PAYE reference number relating to that employer.
- (3) Information disclosed to a specified person under this section may be retained and used for any specified objective.
- (4) Each of the following is a “specified person”—
 - (a) the Employers' Liability Tracing Office (“the Office”);
 - (b) an employer;
 - (c) an employers' liability insurer (“an insurer”).
- (5) Each of the following is a “specified objective”—
 - (a) enabling or assisting the Office to maintain a database of employers' liability insurance held by employers, to be searched on receipt of a relevant request;
 - (b) enabling an insurer to provide information to the Office for the purposes of paragraph (a);
 - (c) enabling an employer to obtain insurance and to provide information for the purposes of this subsection.
- (6) In this section—

“PAYE reference number” has the meaning given by the Employers' Duties (Implementation) Regulations) 2010;

“the Revenue and Customs” has the meaning given by section 17(3) of the Commissioners for Revenue and Customs Act 2005.”
