EXPLANATORY NOTES ON COMMONS AMENDMENTS

What these notes do

- 1 These Explanatory Notes relate to the Commons Amendments to the National Citizen Service Bill [HL] as brought from the House of Commons on 16 March 2017.
- 2 These Explanatory Notes have been prepared by the Department for Culture, Media and Sport in order to assist the reader of the Bill and the Commons amendments, and to help inform debate on the Commons amendments. They do not form part of the Bill and have not been endorsed by Parliament.
- 3 These Explanatory Notes, like the Commons amendments themselves, refer to Bill 114, the Bill as first printed for the Commons.
- 4 These Explanatory Notes need to be read in conjunction with the Commons amendments and the text of the Bill. They are not, and are not meant to be, a comprehensive description of the Commons amendments.
- 5 Commons Amendments 1 and 2 were tabled in the name of the Minister.

Commentary on Commons amendments

Commons Amendments to Clause 13: Extent

Commons Amendment 1

- 6 Commons Amendment 1 would provide that amendments made by the Bill to other enactments would have the same extent as the provision being amended.

Commons Amendments to Clause 14: Commencement

Commons Amendment 2

- 7 Commons Amendment 2 would provide that clause 11 of the Bill (which introduces the amendments to other enactments listed in Schedule 2 to the Bill) would not come into force until a day appointed by the Secretary of State by regulations. The consequential amendments to other enactments would then come into force on a day appointed by the Secretary of State.
