Clause 2

BARONESS HENIG

Page 2, line 47, at end insert –

- “() Regulations under subsection (1) may not be used to make provision which will have the effect of lowering marketing standards for agricultural products below European Union standards.”

Clause 3

BARONESS HENIG

Page 3, line 39, at end insert –

- “() A report under subsection (3) must be drawn up by an organisation independent of Her Majesty’s Government and must include an economic analysis of the impact of the changed agreement.”

Page 3, line 43, at end insert –

- “(5A) A Minister of the Crown must lay a report before both Houses of Parliament during each session of Parliament reporting on the progress made in all negotiations relating to agreements Her Majesty’s Government intends to ratify under section 3.
- (5B) A report under subsection (5A) must include, at a minimum –
- (a) a summary of proposed changes against the existing agreement,
 - (b) the estimated date for the completion of the negotiations, and
 - (c) the date when the agreement is expected to be laid before Parliament.”

Clause 4

BARONESS HENIG

Page 4, line 10, at end insert “and Ministers have previously informed Parliament of the proposed changes to the agreement”

Clause 4 - *continued*

Page 4, line 13, leave out “as soon as practicable after the agreement is ratified” and insert “within 10 days of ratification”
