Clause 1

LORD MCCOLL OF DULWICH

Page 1, line 22, leave out from beginning of line 22 to end of line 2 on page 2 and insert—

“(6B) The consent of the person concerned is only deemed once a person in a qualifying relationship affirms that the person concerned would not have objected to the activity.”

After Clause 1

LORD MCCOLL OF DULWICH

Insert the following new Clause—

“Five year review of the effectiveness of deemed consent

- (1) The Secretary of State must at least once in every five year period beginning with the day on which this Act is passed lay before Parliament a report which includes analysis and evidence on whether the introduction of deemed consent under section 3 of the Human Tissue Act 2004 has been effective in increasing the number of organ and tissue donations.
- (2) The report under subsection (1) must take into account other developments that may have affected the number of organ and tissue donations.”
