LORD MANCROFT

- 1★ Page 2, line 3, at end insert –
““travelling circus” means –
(a) a circus –
(i) which travels from place to place for the purpose of giving performances, displays or exhibitions, and
(ii) as part of which wild animals are kept or introduced (whether for the purpose of performance, display or otherwise), and
(b) any place where a wild animal associated with such a circus is kept;”
- 2★ Page 2, line 4, leave out from “means” to end of line 5 and insert “any animal or bird which is or (before it was taken) was living wild.”
- 3★ Page 2, line 5, at end insert –
“() A bird shall not be treated as living wild if its parents were lawfully in captivity when the egg from which it hatched was laid.”
