Make provision to enable the civil enforcement of moving traffic contraventions using approved devices.

**B**E IT ENACTED by the Queen’s most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

## **1 Civil enforcement of moving traffic contraventions**

(1) The Secretary of State must make provision by regulations under section 72 (civil penalties for road traffic contraventions) of the Traffic Management Act 2004 to enable any enforcement authority to impose a penalty charge on the basis of a record produced by an approved device in respect of a moving traffic contravention under paragraph 8 of Schedule 7 to that Act within six months of this Act coming into force. 5

(2) In this section—  
“approved device” means a device of a type which has been certified by the Secretary of State as one which meets the scheduled requirements in the Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (Approved Devices) (England) Order 2007 (SI 2007/3486); 10  
“enforcement authority” has the meaning given in Part 2 of Schedule 8 to the Traffic Management Act 2004.

## **2 Extent, commencement and short title** 15

- (1) This Act extends to England and Wales only.
- (2) This Act comes into force on the day on which it is passed.
- (3) This Act may be cited as the Traffic Management (Approved Devices) Act 2020.
