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TO

Empower local authorities to introduce Workplace Parking Levies with immediate effect and to impose penalty charges for moving traffic contraventions.

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen’s most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 Workplace charging scheme applications

- (1) The Secretary of State must provide by regulations made by statutory instrument for a Workplace Parking Levy licensing scheme under section 184 (confirmation of licensing schemes) of the Transport Act 2000 to come into force immediately once the order making it has been submitted by the licensing authority or licensing authorities. 5
- (2) A statutory instrument containing regulations under this section may not be made unless a draft of the instrument has been laid before and approved by a resolution of each House of Parliament.

2 Designation of civil enforcement areas for moving traffic contraventions outside Greater London 10

- (1) The Secretary of State must make orders designating the whole of each local authority area in England not already so designated as a civil enforcement area for moving traffic contraventions in accordance with section 74 of and paragraph 10 of Schedule 8 to the Traffic Management Act 2004 within six months of this Act coming into force. 15
- (2) A “local authority” has the meaning given in section 1 (meaning of “local authority” in Part I) of the Local Government Act 2000.

3 Extent, commencement and short title

- (1) This Act extends to England and Wales only. 20
- (2) This Act comes into force on the day on which it is passed.

- (3) This Act may be cited as the Local Authorities (Transport Powers) Act 2020.
