BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 Personal care provision

A local authority must provide free personal care on the basis of need, regardless of medical diagnosis, to an adult who is ordinarily resident in the authority's area or is present in its area but of no settled residence.

2 Extent, commencement and short title

- (1) This Act extends to England and Wales only.
- (2) This Act comes into force on the day on which it is passed.
- (3) This Act may be cited as the Provision of Personal Care Act 2020.
