Clause 37

LORD ANDERSON OF IPSWICH

Page 34, line 35, leave out from “subsection (1)” to end of line 37 and insert “after “Secretary of State” leave out “is satisfied, on the balance of probabilities,” and insert—

- “(a) for the first year of the TPIM, has reasonable grounds for suspecting;
and
- (b) for any further years of the TPIM, is satisfied on the balance of probabilities,””

Member’s explanatory statement

This amendment would leave in place the existing standard of proof for the second and subsequent years of any TPIM notice.

Clause 38

LORD ANDERSON OF IPSWICH

Page 35, line 3, leave out “one or more” and insert “up to three”

Member’s explanatory statement

This amendment would impose a four-year limit for TPIM notices.
