Amend the requirements for making quality contract schemes under the Transport Act 2000.

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen’s most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 Amendment of requirements for making quality contracts schemes

- (1) Section 124 of the Transport Act 2000 (c. 38) (quality contracts schemes) is amended as follows.
- (2) In subsection (1), for paragraphs (a) and (b), substitute the words “the proposed scheme will implement the policies set out in their bus strategy or strategies in a way which is economic, efficient and effective.”

2 Short title, commencement and extent

- (1) This Act may be cited as the Bus Services (Quality Contracts Schemes) Act 2005.
- (2) This Act shall come into force at the end of a period of two months beginning with the date on which it is passed.
- (3) This Act extends to England and Wales only.
