Clause **5**, Page **3**, line **29**, at end insert –

“() The power under section 4(1), so far as relating to compulsory acquisition by virtue of subsection (1), includes power to acquire rights or to impose restrictive covenants for the benefit of a person other than the Secretary of State.” **(1)**

Clause **60**, Page **25**, line **16**, at end insert –

““bridleway”, “carriageway” and “footpath” have the same meanings as in the Highways Act 1980;” **(2)**

Clause **60**, Page **25**, line **46**, at end insert –

““owner”, in relation to any land, has the same meaning as in Part 1 of the Acquisition of Land Act 1981 (but this does not apply to Schedule 13, which has its own definition);” **(3)**

Schedule **17**, Page **145**, line **26**, at end insert –

“(aa) for the matters in sub-paragraph (1)(c) and (e), the Canal & River Trust so far as the matters relate to inland waters owned or managed by the Trust or land associated with such waters,” **(4)**

Schedule **17**, Page **145**, line **27**, leave out “to (e)” and insert “and (e) other than as mentioned in paragraph (aa)” **(5)**
