**Motability governance review**

Before our evidence session on Wednesday 8 January, you sent our Committees on request a summary of the recommendations from the governance review undertaken by Farrer & Co which was presented to the governors of Motability Charity in July 2018.

In the document provided to us, recommendations 35 and 42 were redacted. You told us that these redactions were necessary on grounds of commercial sensitivity.

We enclose correspondence from the Comptroller and Auditor General in which he confirms that, in his view, recommendations 35 and 42 are neither commercially sensitive, nor would compromise value for money if disclosed.

Could you please therefore provide our committees with an unredacted summary of the recommendations from your governance review?
