Motability governance review

Before our evidence session on Wednesday 8 January, Motability Charity sent our Committees on request a summary of the recommendations from the governance review undertaken by Farrer & Co which was presented to the governors of Motability Charity in July 2018.

In the document provided to us, recommendations 35 and 42 were redacted. Motability claim that these redactions were necessary on grounds of commercial sensitivity, in view of the fact that select committees have the power to publish any documents provided to them.

We are aware that the National Audit Office was provided with an unredacted copy during its inquiry into Motability. Could you please confirm to us in writing whether, in your view, these two recommendations are indeed commercially sensitive?
