## **CORRIGENDUM**

In Para 11, lines 6–10 should instead read:

“Staff in YOIs and STCs (but in no other children’s institutions) are permitted to deliberately inflict pain on children, but the Standing Committee for Youth Justice told us that: “Whether inducing pain is officially sanctioned or not, children will experience restraint as painful, so it is important to avoid a proposition that ‘pain free’ restraint is possible.”<sup>23</sup>”
