Make provision for the devolution of timescales, time zones and the subject-matter of the Summer Time Act 1972.

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen’s most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 Scotland

In section L5 of Schedule 5 to the Scotland Act 1998 omit “Timescales, time zones and the subject-matter of the Summer Time Act 1972”.

2 Wales

Under section 58 of the Government of Wales Act 2006, the Minister shall lay before each House of Parliament a draft statutory instrument containing an Order in Council to transfer functions relating to timescales, time zones and the subject-matter of the Summer Time Act 1972 to Welsh ministers. 5

3 Short title and commencement

- (1) This Act may be cited as the Devolution (Time) Act 2010. 10
- (2) This Act shall come into force on the day on which it is passed.
